



Possible Questions to Ask During an Interview with a Potential Pet Sitter

- I see that NAPPS Certification is available through NAPPS. What does that entail and are you Certified?
- Do you run background checks on your staff?
- Tell me/us a little about your pet sitting background. (What are your qualifications and experience?)
- Would you provide me/us a list of references?
- Are you insured? Are your employees or independent contractors bonded?
- Describe a routine visit with my pet.
- What are your procedures for dealing with pet emergencies?
- Do you have a plan for inclement weather and other emergencies?
- What forms of medication are you able to administer?
- How do you care for my home while I am gone?
- How do you keep my keys secure?
- What are the costs involved for caring for my pet?
- What are your rates and what payment methods do you accept?
